SECTION 1. The St. Bernard Parish Council, as the Governing Authority of the Parish, does hereby **amend** Chapter 11, Health and Sanitation; to create and add Article X, Factories, Plants, Etc., Creating Noxious Odors of the St. Bernard Parish Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as per attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the authorizing signature by the Parish President. In the event of a presidential veto, this Ordinance shall become effective upon a two-thirds favorable vote of the total membership of the Council pursuant to Sections 2-11 and 2-13 of the St. Bernard Parish Home Rule Charter.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph provision or portion of this Ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expressing and declaring that it would have adopted the remaining portion(s) of this Ordinance with the invalid portion(s) omitted.

Chapter 11 – Health and Sanitation

Article X – Factories, Plants, Etc., Creating Noxious Odors

ARTICLE X. FACTORIES, PLANTS, ETC., CREATING NOXIOUS ODORS

Sec. 11-315. Inspections.

Any plant or factory operating, or which may operate in the parish which may diffuse smoke, steam, dust, noxious gases, fumes or nauseous smells which cause serious and material discomfort, annoyance or injury to persons living in close proximity shall be inspected by the Office of Community Development or Code Enforcement so that any of the said nuisances created by the operation of such plant or manufactory shall be discontinued or minimized.

Sec. 11-316. Report of inspection.

(a) The Office of Community Development or Code Enforcement after making the inspection required herein, shall file written report with Housing Redevelopment Quality of Life Commission with recommendations for the suspension or discontinuance of such operation depending upon the extent of annoyance, discomfort and harm caused persons living in close proximity thereto, or the manner in which the public health and convenience of the community may be injuriously affected.

(b) By majority vote, the Housing Redevelopment Quality of Life Commission may authorize the furnishing of the report to the BAA Hearing Officer for a hearing to be held.

Sec. 11-317. Entry powers.

The parish health inspector or any person duly authorized by the Office of Community Development or Code Enforcement may enter, examine and inspect all plants and factories and adjacent grounds to carry out the provisions of this article.

Sec. 11-318. Penalty for violations.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this article or of any order of suspension or closing of such plant or factory shall be considered guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof by a court of competent jurisdiction, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or serve fifteen (15) days in the parish jail; and every violation thereof on separate days shall constitute separate offenses subject to said penalties.

Chapter 11 – Health and Sanitation

Article X – Factories, Plants, Etc., Creating Noxious Odors

ARTICLE X. FACTORIES, PLANTS, ETC., CREATING NOXIOUS ODORS

Sec. 11-315. Inspections.

Any plant or factory operating, or which may operate in the parish which may diffuse smoke, steam, dust, noxious gases, fumes or nauseous smells which cause serious and material discomfort, annoyance or injury to persons living in close proximity shall be inspected by the Office of Community Development or Code Enforcement so that any of the said nuisances created by the operation of such plant or manufactory shall be discontinued or minimized.

Sec. 11-316. Report of inspection.

(a) The Office of Community Development or Code Enforcement after making the inspection required herein, shall file written report with Housing Redevelopment Quality of Life Commission with recommendations for the suspension or discontinuance of such operation depending upon the extent of annoyance, discomfort and harm caused persons living in close proximity thereto, or the manner in which the public health and convenience of the community may be injuriously affected.

(b) By majority vote, the Housing Redevelopment Quality of Life Commission may authorize the furnishing of the report to the BAA Hearing Officer for a hearing to be held.

Sec. 11-317. Entry powers.

The parish health inspector or any person duly authorized by the Office of Community Development or Code Enforcement may enter, examine and inspect all plants and factories and adjacent grounds to carry out the provisions of this article.

Sec. 11-318. Penalty for violations.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this article or of any order of suspension or closing of such plant or factory shall be considered guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof by a court of competent jurisdiction, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or serve fifteen (15) days in the parish jail; and every violation thereof on separate days shall constitute separate offenses subject to said penalties.
