President's Report **Council Meeting of Tuesday, September 3, 2019**

Good evening Council Members, Ladies and Gentlemen:

FIRE INSURANCE RATING – We have received notice of classification improvements for both Fire District 1 and Fire District 2. Effective October 7th, the Public Protection Classification of St. Bernard Parish Fire District 1 has improved from Class 3 to Class 2 and St. Bernard Parish Fire District 2 has improved from Class 4 to Class 2. All residential and most commercial properties within these fire districts will receive Class 2 rates. These ratings are St. Bernard Parish's highest ratings ever. This rating is now referred to as a Community Rating, 10% 9-1-1 Operations, 40% Water Distribution and 50% Fire Department operations." **The new classifications may result in decreased fire insurance premiums.**
