EXTRACT OF THE OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE PARISH OF ST. BERNARD, STATE OF LOUISIANA, TAKEN AT A REGULAR MEETING HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS OF THE ST. BERNARD PARISH GOVERNMENT COMPLEX, 8201 WEST JUDGE PEREZ DRIVE, CHALMETTE, LOUISIANA ON TUESDAY, MAY 4, 2021 AT SEVEN O'CLOCK P.M.

On motion of Ms. Callais, seconded by Mr. McCloskey, it was moved to adopt the following resolution:

## **RESOLUTION SBPC #2128-05-21**

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN THE PARISH OF ST. BERNARD, STATE OF LOUISIANA, ON SATURDAY, APRIL 24, 2021, TO AUTHORIZE THE LEVY OF SPECIAL TAXES THEREIN.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Bernard, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the Parish of St. Bernard, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), that:

**SECTION 1. Canvass.** This Governing Authority does now proceed in open and public session to examine the official tabulations of votes cast at the special election held in the Parish of St. Bernard, State of Louisiana, on SATURDAY, APRIL 24, 2021 (the "Election"), to authorize the levy of special taxes therein pursuant to the following propositions (the "Propositions"):

### **PROPOSITION NO. 1 OF 2 (DRAINAGE MILLAGE)**

Shall the Parish of St. Bernard, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), levy a special tax of eight (8) mills on all property subject to taxation within the Parish (an estimated \$3,283,500 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the tax for an entire year), for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2021 and ending with the year 2030, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, operating and maintaining drainage canals, pumps, pumping plants, dykes, small levees and other drainage works, including all necessary equipment, within and for the Parish?

### **PROPOSITION NO. 2 OF 2 (FIRE MILLAGE CONTINUATION)**

Shall the Parish of St. Bernard, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), continue to levy a special tax of twenty and eighty-five hundredths (20.85) mills on all property subject to taxation within the Parish (an estimated \$8,557,700 reasonably expected at this

time to be collected from the levy of the tax for an entire year), for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2023 and ending with the year 2032, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, maintaining, improving and operating fire protection facilities and purchasing fire trucks and other fire fighting equipment in the Parish, said millage to represent a eighty-five hundredths of a mill (.85) increase (due to reappraisal) over the 20 mills tax authorized to be levied through the year 2022 pursuant to an election held on December 8, 2012?

This Governing Authority does further proceed to examine and canvass the returns of the Election thereof.

**SECTION 2. Election Results.** According to the official certified tabulation of votes cast at said Election,

- (i) there was a total of **1,725** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** Proposition No. 1 and a total of **1,185** votes cast **AGAINST** Proposition No. 1, resulting in a majority of **540** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** Proposition No. 1; and
- (ii) there was a total of **1,828** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** Proposition No. 2 and a total of **1,079** votes cast **AGAINST** Proposition No. 2, resulting in a majority of **749** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** Proposition No. 2.

The Propositions were therefore duly **CARRIED** by a majority of the votes cast by the qualified electors voting at the Election.

**SECTION 3. Promulgation of Election Result.** The results of said election shall be promulgated by publication in the manner provided by law, after receipt from the Secretary of State's office of the actual costs of the election, as required by Act 205 of the Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana for the year 2019.

**SECTION 4. Declaration.** The foregoing results of the Election are hereby declared by this Governing Authority and shall be published as required by law.

**SECTION 5. Procès Verbal.** A *Procès Verbal* of the canvass of the returns of the Election shall be made and a certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, who shall record the same in his office; another certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Clerk of Court and *Ex-Officio* Recorder of Mortgages in and for the Parish of St. Bernard, who shall record the same in the Mortgage Records of said Parish; and another copy thereof shall be retained in the archives of this Governing Authority.





Pursuant to the provisions of a resolution adopted by the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Bernard, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the Parish of St. Bernard, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), on January 5, 2021, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special election will be held within the Parish on **SATURDAY, APRIL 24, 2021**, and that at the said election there will be submitted to all registered voters in the Parish qualified and entitled to vote at the said election under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Louisiana and the Constitution of the United States, the following propositions, to-wit:

Said special election will be held at each and every polling place in the Parish of St. Bernard, which polls will open at seven o'clock (7:00) a.m. and close at eight o'clock (8:00) p.m., in accordance with the provisions of La. R.S. 18:541.

The polling places at the precincts in the Parish are hereby designated as the polling places at which to hold the said election, and the Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners, respectively, shall be those persons designated according to law.

The estimated cost of this election as determined by the Secretary of State based upon the provisions of Chapter 8-A of Title 18 and actual costs of similar elections is \$36,500.

Notice is further given that a portion of the monies collected from the taxes described in the Propositions shall be remitted to certain state and statewide retirement systems in the manner required by law.

The said special election will be held in accordance with the applicable provisions of Chapter 5 and Chapter 6-A of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, and other constitutional and statutory authority, and the officers appointed to hold the said election, as provided in this Notice of Special Election, or such substitutes therefor as may be selected and designated in accordance with La. R.S. 18:1287, will make due returns thereof to said Governing Authority, and NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that the Governing Authority will meet at its regular meeting place, the Government Complex, 8201 W. Judge Perez Dr., Chalmette, Louisiana, on **TUESDAY, MAY 4, 2021**, at **SEVEN O'CLOCK (7:00) P.M.**, and shall then and there in open and public session proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the results of the said special election. All registered voters of the Parish are entitled to vote at said special election and voting machines will be used.





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
