AN ORDINANCE TO **AMEND** CHAPTER 11, HEALTH AND SANITATION; ARTICLE I, IN GENERAL; SECTION 11-2, ENFORCEMENT OF GRASS CUTTING REQUIREMENTS; VIOLATIONS; PENALTIES OF THE ST. BERNARD PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES.

ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The St. Bernard Parish Council, the Governing Authority, does hereby ordain that chapter 11, health and sanitation; article i, in general; section 11-2, enforcement of grass cutting requirements; violations; penalties of the St. Bernard Parish Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as per attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon authorizing signature by the Parish President. In the event of a presidential veto, this Ordinance shall become effective upon a two-thirds favorable vote of the total membership of the Council pursuant to Sections 2-11 and 2-13 of the St. Bernard Parish Home Rule Charter.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this Ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expresses and declares that it would have adopted the remaining portion this Ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.

Ordinance SBPC #2410-02-22

Chapter 11 – Health and Sanitation

Article I – In General

Section 11-2 – Enforcement of grass cutting requirements; violations; penalties.

Sec. 11-2. – Enforcement of grass cutting requirements; violations; penalties.

- (i) In addition to the remedy provided in subsection (h) hereinabove, upon the failure of any such property owner to pay the charges provided for in this Section, the parish shall record the notice provided in this Section in the mortgage records of St. Bernard Parish. This recordation will act as a lien upon the property which is the basis of the charges assessed pursuant to this Section; and said lien will be in the amount of all assessed fines, charges, and costs.
- (j) A party who asserts that the charges and liens recited hereinabove have been wrongfully assessed may appeal such action to the 34th Judicial District Court for the Parish of St. Bernard, State of Louisiana. Any such appeal shall be filed no later than sixty (60) days following the assessment of said charge or creation of said lien.
