## **RESOLUTION SBPC #2206-01-22**

A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE LOUISIANA STATE LEGISLATURES AND FEDERAL DELEGATION FUND A INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT USING THE FUNDS ASSOCIATED WITH LOUISIANA'S PORTION OF THE FEDERAL INFRASTRUCTURE BILL.

**WHEREAS**, St. Bernard Parish is the fastest growing community in the state; and,

**WHEREAS**, One of many goals of St. Bernard Parish Government is to promote economic development and quality of life through more opportunities for our residents in the form of new and higher paying jobs; and,

**WHEREAS**, St. Bernard Parish's current infrastructure road, rail, and drainage cannot sustain the projected rate of population growth or support any large scale future development projects; and,

**WHEREAS**, the growth of St. Bernard Parish will be adversely effected without funding for new infrastructure projects and improvements to existing infrastructure; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Infrastructure Bill has funding available for road, rail, and drainage infrastructure projects; and,

**WHEREAS**, the St. Bernard Parish Government is requesting assistance from the Louisiana State Legislatures and Federal Delegation to engineer and fund much needed infrastructure to aid the future developments and growth of St. Bernard Parish.
