President's Report Council Meeting of Tuesday, December 6, 2016

Good Evening Councilmembers, Ladies and Gentlemen:

The 2016 holiday season has arrived! The recent cold snap makes it feel more like winter. As the holiday shopping season is underway, we would like to encourage all residents to shop local and support our local businesses. Not only does this help create and sustain local jobs but it helps improve the local business economy.

December is the most festive time of year and St. Bernard Parish is filled with many holiday activities that is sure to put everyone in the Christmas spirit. There was a great turnout at the first annual Christmas at the Complex Ceremony this past Friday. I would like to thank everyone who attended, participated in and organized the event. Our goal is to grow this family-friendly event bigger and better every year into an occasion that the residents of our community look forward to. St. Bernard Parish has a lot to offer and we hope everyone will join us in attending the many community events during this holiday season.

The Housing Department recently served 65 low income residents with food baskets for the Thanksgiving holiday. We are pleased that the outreach programs offered through the St. Bernard Parish Housing Department are working to serve the residents of St. Bernard Parish.

The Animal Shelter participated in Jefferson Parish's Pet Fest at Lafreniere Park on November 20th where six St. Bernard Animal Shelter dogs found forever homes. Through the LASPCA, the Animal Shelter was able to send nine dogs to Chicago and over the past month, has been successful in the placement of four breed specific rescues. As part of the wellness program, employees recently had the opportunity to participate in on-site, no cost wellness screenings which consisted of blood pressure, cholesterol and diabetes lab work and flu shots. Safety manager, Robert Barton, is currently performing vehicle safety inspections on all St. Bernard Parish Government vehicles. We would like to thank all of the departments for their cooperation throughout this process.

The Fire Department is conducting their annual pump testing of apparatus this week. We would like to thank Crew Boats, Inc. who allows this testing to be conducted at their Paris Road facility every December. The Fire Department had two new Fire Recruits graduate from the LSU Fire Academy on Friday after 14 weeks of intense training. Upon graduation, they will receive six national certifications and soon they will be attending advanced shipboard firefighting at Delgado Community College's Marine Fire School. Last week two Firefighters attended a week of industrial firefighting training in Beaumont, Texas. We want to thank Valero for sponsoring this very important training.

As a convenience to our community, the La. Department of Wildlife and Fisheries will be on the 2nd floor of the Government Complex from December 13th - 15th from 8:30 am - 3:30 pm offering new commercial fishing licenses and renewal.

We invite the community to join us in all of this year's holiday celebrations.
