AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 11; HEALTH AND SANITATION; TO CREATE AND ADD ARTICLE VIII, PROHIBITING THE SALE AND DISTRIBUTION OF IMPORTED SHRIMP; OF THE ST. BERNARD PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES.

ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

WHEREAS, The St. Bernard Parish Council believes it is in the best interest of the citizens of St. Bernard Parish and St Bernard Parish Government to create and add Chapter 11 Health and Sanitation; Article VIII, Prohibiting the Sale and Distribution of Imported Shrimp.

WHEREAS, The St. Bernard Parish Council does hereby declare that the Sale and Distribution of Imported Shrimp is a serious problem affecting the health and welfare of all citizens.

SECTION 1. The St. Bernard Parish Council does hereby add the following to Chapter 11; Article VIII, Sale and Distribution of Imported Shrimp as attached in Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon authorizing signature by the Parish President. If the proposed ordinance is not signed or vetoed by the Parish President within Twelve (12) hours after receipt it shall be considered adopted. As an emergency ordinance, the provisions shall remain valid for a time period of sixty (60) days.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this Ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expresses and declares that it would have adopted the remaining portion this Ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.

Emergency Ordinance SBPC #2463-11-22

Chapter 11 – Health and Sanitation

Article VIII – Prohibiting the Sale and Distribution of Imported Shrimp

Section 11-311- Sale and Distribution Prohibited.

- a. It shall be illegal for any person, vendor, seller, or retailer licensed to do business in St. Bernard Parish to sell or distribute imported shrimp in the Parish of St. Bernard.**

Section 11-312- Penalties

- a. Whoever violates the provisions of this section shall be fined not more than five hundred (\$500.00) or imprisoned for not more than six (6) months, or both.**
- b. Whoever violates the provisions of this section for a second offense shall be fine one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than six months, or both.**
- c. Whoever violates the provisions of this section for a third or subsequent offense shall be fine one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) or imprisoned for not more than six (6) months, or both. However, if the offender is a vendor, seller or retailer licensed to do business in St. Bernard Parish it shall forfeit and/or have all business licensed revoked by the Parish in addition to the above-stated penalties.**
