BERNARD PARISH GOVERNMENT COMPLEX, 8201 WEST JUDGE PEREZ DRIVE, CHALMETTE, LOUISIANA ON TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 7, 2023 AT SEVEN O'CLOCK P.M.

On motion of Mr. Everhardt, seconded by Ms. Callais, it was moved to adopt the following resolution:

## RESOLUTION SBPC #2285-02-23

A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE COASTAL PROTECTION AND RESTORATION AUTHORITY (CPRA) TO EITHER IMMEDIATELY READJUST THE CAERNARVON DIVERSION OUTFLOW TO A LOWER "CFS" OR IMMEDIATELY TERMINATE THE CAERNARVON FRESHWATER DIVERSION SYSTEM COMPLETELY.

WHEREAS, that the St. Bernard Parish Council does hereby request the (CPRA) to either immediately readjust the Caernarvon diversion outflow to a lower cubic flow per second (CFS) discharge or immediately terminate the Caernarvon fresh water diversion system completely due to its negative impact on the wetlands, commercial fishing industry and recreational fishing, and the Quality of Life and Safety of the residents in St. Bernard Parish.

WHEREAS, St. Bernard Parish and its citizens have suffered greatly as a result of catastrophic coastal land loss and environmental degradation over the past century, and is currently being threatened with the exacerbation of coastal land loss and environmental degradation resulting from the ongoing and unprecedented influx of Mississippi River water into St. Bernard Parish's waterways and estuaries, which is adversely impacting the viability of the Parish's economically and culturally significant commercial and recreational industries as well as the health, safety, welfare, and resilience of its citizens; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the St. Bernard Parish Council, the governing authority does hereby request Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority (CPRA) to either immediately readjust the Caernarvon diversion outflow to a lower "CFS" or immediately terminate the Caernarvon freshwater diversion system completely.


The Council Chair, Mr. Lewis, cast his vote as **YEA**.
