WHEREAS, on December 12th 2022 Carolyn Park Playground was hit by an EF2 Tornado damaging the fence, electrical system, and concession and bathroom area; and,

Innovative Readiness Training Program

St. Bernard Parish Government in conjunction with the Carolyn Park Booster Club intends to solicit assistance from the Department of Defense's Innovative Readiness Training Program (IRT). The assistance will include fence repair and rebuilding of the concession stand and bathrooms that were damaged by a tornado on December 14, 2022. The proposed assistance will take place at 101 Lynx Drive, Arabi La 70032 in the Fall of 2023 for a duration of 2 months. Construction contractors, labor unions, or private individuals who have questions or who wish to voice opposition to military assistance for this project may contact Jason Stopa from the Office of Community Development at 504-278-4310 or via e-mail at jstopa@sbpg.net no later than thirty (30) days after the first publication of this notice. Persons not filing comments within the time frame noted will be considered to have waived their objections to military assistance for this project.

Scope of Work

Phase 1

Project Scope

Priority: 1 (Highest)

Objective: Make the park baseline operational

Timeline: Before Fall sports programs begin

Construction Duration Estimate: 2.5 months

Fence

- 3rd Base Line – 120 ft of 20 ft fence
- 3rd Base Line – 180 ft of 10 ft fence
- 1st Base Line – 120 ft of 20 ft fence
- 1st Base Line – 120 ft of 6 ft fence
- Canal line – 250 ft of 6 ft fence
- 4 Dug Outs
- 2 Backstops
- 1 Large Swing Gate at Lynx
- 1 slide gate at parking area near Badger

Concession Stand and Bathroom

- Saw cut 8 ft out of the existing deck
- Remove the two shipping containers on slab
- Build a residential construction style concession stand and bathroom structure
 - Structure to be built on concrete block on top of existing slab
 - Dimensions 16' x 50'
 - 9 ft ceilings
 - Hardy board front
 - Low pitched shingled roof
 - 2/ 2 stall bathrooms
 - handicap accessible x 1 in each
 - 1 roll up window for concession service
 - Build out and installation of all MEP (Mechanical Electrical and Plumbing)
 - Build out of concession area
