BERNARD PARISH GOVERNMENT COMPLEX, 8201 WEST JUDGE PEREZ DRIVE, CHALMETTE, LOUISIANA ON TUESDAY, JULY 18, 2023 AT THREE O'CLOCK P.M.

On motion of Mr. Everhardt, seconded by Mrs. Callais, it was moved to **adopt** the following Emergency Ordinance:

## **EMERGENCY ORDINANCE SBPC #2506-07-23**

### **Summary No. 4102**

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE SBPC #2483-04-23, AN ORDINANCE TO HAVE THE ADMINISTRATION IMMEDIATELY PUT BACK IN PLACE THE ENTIRE STAFFING AND EQUIPMENT LEVELS OF FIRE DISTRICT 2 TO ITS LEVELS AS IT WAS PRIOR TO MARCH 6, 2023.

ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

**WHEREAS**, Administration and Council has agreed to continue to staff, maintain, and operate Fire Stations 8, 10 & 11 while concurrently working on preserving Fire Station 12 to prepare for future use; and,

**WHEREAS**, in order for Administration to move forward with the agreed plan for Fire Stations 8, 10, 11, & 12, **Ordinance SBPC #2483-04-23** must be repealed.

**SECTION 1.** That **Ordinance SBPC #2483-04-23** put Fire District 2 back in service as it was prior to March 6, 2023 to protect the lives and property of the people of District E, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**SECTION 2.** Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon authorizing signature by the Parish President. If the proposed ordinance is not signed or vetoed by the Parish President within Twelve (12) hours after receipt it shall be considered adopted. As an emergency ordinance, the provisions shall remain valid for a time period of sixty (60) days.

**SECTION 3.** Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expresses and declares that it would have adopted the remaining portion of this Ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.




