AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE SBPC #2472-12-22, CHAPTER 11; HEALTH AND SANITATION; ARTICLE IX, PROHIBITING THE SALE AND DISTRIBUTION OF IMPORTED SHRIMP, CRAB MEAT AND CRAWFISH; TO CREATE AND ADD SECTION 11-314 ENFORCEMENT OF THE ST. BERNARD PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES.

ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The St. Bernard Parish Council, the Governing Authority, does hereby amend Chapter 11 Health and Sanitation; Article IX, Prohibiting the Sale and Distribution of Imported Shrimp, Crab Meat and Crawfish, to create and add Section 11-314 Enforcement of the St. Bernard Parish Code of Ordinances as per attached in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the authorizing signature by the Parish President. In the event of a presidential veto, this Ordinance shall become effective upon a two-thirds favorable vote of the total membership of the Council pursuant to Sections 2-11 and 2-13 of the St. Bernard Parish Home Rule Charter.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this Ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expresses and declares that it would have adopted the remaining portion this Ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.





Chapter 11 – Health and Sanitation

Article IX – Prohibiting the Sale and Distribution of Imported Shrimp, Crab Meat and Crawfish

Section 11-311- Sale and Distribution Prohibited.

- a. It shall be illegal for any person, vendor, seller, or retailer licensed to do business in St. Bernard Parish to sell or distribute imported shrimp, crab meat and crawfish in the Parish of St. Bernard.

Section 11-312 – Definitions

For the purpose of this article, the following terms, phrases and words shall have the meaning given herein, unless it shall be apparent from the context that a different meaning is intended.

Imported – brought into a country from overseas

Section 11- 313- Penalties

- a. Whoever violates the provisions of this section shall be fined not more than five hundred (\$500.00) or imprisoned for not more than six (6) months, or both.
- b. Whoever violates the provisions of this section for a second offense shall be fine one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than six months, or both.
- c. Whoever violates the provisions of this section for a third or subsequent offense shall be fine one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) or imprisoned for not more than six (6) months, or both. However, if the offender is a vendor, seller or retailer licensed to do business in St. Bernard Parish it shall forfeit and/or have all business licensed revoked by the Parish in addition to the above-stated penalties.

Section 11- 314 - Enforcement

- a. It shall be the responsibility of the chief compliance officer or his designee to inspect and issue a citation to any person, vendor, seller, or retailer that is found to be in violation of these requirements. If a violation is identified, notice of the violation shall be sent to the owner. Notice to one (1) owner shall be deemed notice to any co-owner.
- b. Such notice of violation shall be by United States certified mail.
- c. If the notice should be returned by the post office department because of its inability to make delivery thereof or if the owner has refused to accept the notification, notice may be accomplished by publication of the notification in the official journal at least once.

- d. The notice shall contain the following:
 - 1. The date that the violation occurred.
 - 2. It should state if this is the first, second or a third or subsequent offense.
 - 3. An additional charge of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) shall be assessed for the cost of the inspection and administrative costs. Included in this charge will be the cost of mailings, filing and publication of notification in the official journal.
