BERNARD PARISH GOVERNMENT COMPLEX, 8201 WEST JUDGE PEREZ DRIVE, CHALMETTE, LOUISIANA ON WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 18, 2023 AT THREE O'CLOCK P.M.

On motion of Mr. Everhardt, seconded by Mr. McCloskey, it was moved to adopt the following ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PARISH PRESIDENT TO DEDICATE FUNDS THAT ARE CURRENTLY IN THE FIRE CAPITAL FUND TO RENOVATE AND BRING FIRE STATION 12 TO AN OPERATIONAL AND FUNCTIONAL STATUS IMMEDIATELY.

ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. This ordinance will ensure that administration will immediately dedicate \$200,000.00 that is currently in the Fire Capital Fund to Fire Station 12 to allow for immediate renovations; and,

WHEREAS, St. Bernard Parish Council is desirous to return Fire Station 12 to a physical building ready for operations; and,

WHEREAS, the dedicated funds in the amount of \$200,000.00 will allow Fire Station 12 to become a habitable, operational, and a functioning station once again.

SECTION 2. This ordinance will dedicate the funds specifically to renovate and return Fire Station 12 to a physical building ready for immediate operations to protect the lives and property of the people of District E.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon authorizing signature by the Parish President. In the event of a presidential veto, this Ordinance shall become effective upon a two-thirds favorable vote of the total membership of the Council pursuant to Sections 2-11 and 2-13 of the St. Bernard Parish Home Rule Charter.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this Ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expresses and declares that it would have adopted the remaining portion this Ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.
