A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PARISH PRESIDENT TO EXECUTE SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 1 WITH THE LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DEVELOPMENT FOR THE ST. BERNARD PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (STATE PROJECT NUMBER H.014049).

WHEREAS, St. Bernard Parish adopted the *St. Bernard Bikeway and Pedestrian Plan Update* in 2017 and has been working to implement that plan over the last several years; and,

WHEREAS, St. Bernard Parish formed the St. Bernard Parish Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee to provide input into the implementation of the plan; and,

WHEREAS, this Committee identified its first priority pedestrian projects as improvements to crossings along Paris Road near Prompt Succor Church and near the Winn Dixie shopping center, and construction of new sidewalks in Violet along Judge Perez Drive; and,

WHEREAS, the Parish was able to secure a Unified Work Program Grant through the Regional Planning Commission for Jefferson, Orleans, Plaquemines, St. Bernard, St. Charles, St. John the Baptist, St. Tammany and Tangipahoa Parishes (RPC) for the St. Bernard Pedestrian Improvements Project in 2018 in the amount of \$378,000 (\$302,400 80% federal funding and \$75,600 20% local funding); and,

WHEREAS, St. Bernard Parish secured the services of Kyle and Associates to develop engineering plans and bidding documents for this project; and,

WHEREAS, new funding was provided by Congress in the 2021 Bi-Partisan Infrastructure Bill for the Highway Safety Improvement Program with special funding for the Vulnerable Road User Program; and,

WHEREAS, with technical assistance provided by the RPC, St Bernard Parish was able to apply to the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development to utilize this new funding source for the St. Bernard Pedestrian Improvements Project; and,

WHEREAS, securing this new funding will save St. Bernard Parish an estimated \$578,000 due to increased project costs over the original Unified Work Program grant, the agreement by DOTD to fund 100% of this project (no local match for the Parish) and eligibility for DOTD to fund all remaining engineering and related costs under this new federal program; and,

WHEREAS, an amended agreement is required to modify the DOTD agreement previously executed in 2022.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the St. Bernard Parish Council, does hereby authorize the President of St. Bernard Parish Government to sign and submit Supplemental Agreement No. 1 as attached for the St. Bernard Pedestrian Improvements Project (State Project #H.014049) and all of the necessary reports, assurances, and any other related documents required in connection with this funding program.

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 1, is made and executed in two originals on this _____ day of _____, 20____, by and between the **Department of Transportation and Development**, through its Secretary, hereinafter referred to as **DOTD**, and the **St. Bernard Parish**, a political subdivision of the State of Louisiana, hereinafter referred to as **Entity**.

WITNESSETH: That;

WHEREAS, the DOTD and Entity previously entered into a formal agreement, dated August 26, 2022 to provide improved signalization, signage, striping and crossing amenities for pedestrian crossing movements and adding approximately 3100 feet of sidewalk, in Chalmette, St Bernard Parish, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Article I: Project Description, to update the Responsibility Tables for Roadway Control Sections 046-32 and 148-01; to read Yes for DOTD and No for Entity for Construction, Construction Engineering Administration and Inspection, and Construction Engineering Testing, and Article II: Funding, by updating the Funding Tables for Roadway Control Sections 046-32 and 148-01; to read 100% DOTD and 0% Entity for Construction, Construction Engineering Administration and Inspection, and Construction Engineering Testing; and

WHEREAS, DOTD is agreeable to the implementation of this Project and desires to cooperate with the Entity, as hereinafter provided:
