From the Desk of St. Bernard Parish President Louis Pomes

I'm proud and grateful, as always, to briefly share some updates, events, information, and thoughts in this biweekly President's Report. Thank you again for being engaged and committed to the continued growth and prosperity of our beloved community here in St. Bernard Parish.

On Monday, November 11, 2024, St. Bernard Parish proudly hosted our annual **Veterans Day Parade and Recognition Ceremony**. Additionally, with the holiday season upon us, there are many wonderful community events happening in St. Bernard Parish. I am pleased to welcome and congratulate several businesses that were issued or reissued permits by our Office of Community Development here in St. Bernard Parish in the last two weeks. Please join me in supporting these new ventures as they settle into the community, while continuing to support the established businesses that are the backbone of our local economy. These businesses reflect the ongoing growth of our parish. Congratulations again to; **Amazing Hands Home Care Services, Marina Inn and Suites, Sols Jewelry, Smashed Plates, Serigne's Live Bait**.

Lastly, many ongoing **Capital Projects** continue to progress steadily across St. Bernard Parish. In Old Arabi, drainage improvements are ongoing with pipe lining, replacements, and the installation of new drains, while the streetscape project is preparing for sidewalks to be poured. A State Fire Marshal inspection for the ceiling and sprinkler system is scheduled for November 25 at the new public library in Meraux, and preparation work is in progress to pour sidewalks at the site. The Florida Walk project has advanced with sheet pile installation, and pipe lining to begin soon. In the Fanz Trailer Park area, sewer pump rebuilding is underway. Additional projects include pouring sidewalks and driveways on Marquez and prep. work on Fable, where crews are currently addressing a drain line. Vista Park improvements include installing dugout and bleacher covers, completing sheet metal work and HVAC installation on concession area and utility building. Meanwhile, Patricia Park is nearing completion following a final inspection set for December 9, with only minor clean-up remaining.

Thank you for your continued involvement in making St. Bernard Parish a wonderful place to live, work, and raise a family. I am proud of what we've achieved together and look forward to the future we are building.
