AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 22, ZONING; SECTION 22-2, INTERPRETATION; SUBSECTION 22-2-4, DEFINITIONS OF THE ST. BERNARD PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES.

ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The St. Bernard Parish Council, as the Governing Authority of the Parish, does hereby **amend** Chapter 22, Zoning; Section 22-2, Interpretation; Subsection 22-2-4, Definitions of the St. Bernard Parish Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as per attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval of the State of Louisiana. In the event of a presidential veto, this Ordinance shall become effective upon a two-thirds favorable vote of the total membership of the Council and then approved by the State of Louisiana pursuant to Sections 2-11 and 2-13 of the St. Bernard Parish Home Rule Charter.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expressing and declaring that it would have adopted the remaining portion of this ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.

Chapter 22 Zoning
Section 22-2 Interpretation
SubSection 22-42-4 Definitions

Outdoor advertising signs: See section 22-7-4.

Outdoor Commercial Recreation: commercial establishment designed and equipped for the conduct of sports, leisure activities, and other recreational activities wholly or partially outside of any building or structure. Examples of such use include, but are not limited to, outdoor commercial swimming pools, driving ranges, miniature golf facilities, amusement parks, go-cart tracks, and all accessory uses generally associated therewith, such as food services, equipment rental and repairs, and pro-shops.

Stable, public: A stable with a capacity for the housing of more than two (2) horses or mules, which stable may be operated for remuneration, hire, sale or stabling.

Stockyard: any place, establishment, or facility commonly known as stockyards, conducted, operated, or managed for profit or nonprofit as a public market for livestock producers, feeders, market agencies and buyers, consisting of pens, or other enclosures, and their appurtenances, in which live cattle, sheep, swine, horses, mules, or goats are received, held, or kept for sale or shipment in commerce.
