BIWEEKLY PRESIDENT'S REPORT

To the Honorable St. Bernard Parish Councilmembers and Residents,

As we move through the summer season, St. Bernard Parish Government remains focused on improving infrastructure and supporting the people and businesses that keep our community strong. Below are a few timely updates and reminders:

Asphalt patchwork and repairs will begin soon, parish-wide. Meanwhile, drainage crews have moved to Rosetta between E. Genie and Golden, with approximately 500 feet of new pipe left to install. Once complete, they'll shift operations to Nancy Drive. Our concrete crews continue restoration and cleanup efforts in several locations. Restoration and sodding are also still underway at Plaza, Magistrate, and Shannon Dr.

We were recently awarded \$10.6 million in Capital Outlay funding for the construction of a new Fire Station 10 Superstation, a major investment in parish emergency response infrastructure. Other key capital projects are progressing well. The Jean Lafitte Walking Path is nearing completion, with a drainage installation at a key intersection wrapping up the project. Concrete repairs across the parish are almost complete, with only two locations remaining as we begin building the next work list. At the Riverbend Force Main project, all 12-inch pipe has been installed between Debouchel and the Munster Plant. Crews are now working on tie-ins and fusing 18-inch pipe for the next phase. At the Farmsite Sewer Lift Station, engineering plans are being revised to reroute lines through the back servitude to avoid conflict with sidewalks.

We're also happy to report that the flush truck is back out on the streets as of today after returning from the mechanic shop. It will resume its critical role in clearing drains and keeping our systems functioning properly.

Looking ahead to the weekend, the **St. Bernard Seafood Market** will be held this **Saturday, June 21**, from **9 AM to 1 PM** at the **Delacroix Island Pier**, located at **5565 Delacroix Highway**. Come out and support our local fishermen while stocking up on the freshest live seafood around—straight from the water, to the boat, to your ice chest. Please note: this market is cash only.

Also, we have issued several new and renewed business permits in St. Bernard Parish since my last report, including; Wendy's #555, Classic Collision Chalmette, Da Parish Pub, The Beauty Room, Five Micro School, Prince Dump Truck Services, HSC Communications, Paris Casino, and Ultimate Auto Glass. We thank each of these businesses for choosing to serve our community and wish them continued success.

I appreciate the continued support and engagement of our community, and as always it is my privilege to lead and serve St. Bernard Parish.
