## ORDINANCE SBPC #2695-11-25

AN ORDINANCE TO **AMEND** CHAPTER 12, MOBILE HOMES AND MOBILE HOME PARKS; TRAILERS AND TRAILER PARKS; HOUSE COURTS, TENT CAMP SPACES, ETC; ARTICLE II, HOUSE COURTS, TENT CAMP SPACES, ETC.; SECTION 12-56, VIOLATIONS AND ARTICLE III, FLOOD AND WIND PROTECTION; SECTION 12-66, PENALTY OF THE ST. BERNARD PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES.

### ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

**SECTION 1.** The St. Bernard Parish Council, as the Governing Authority of the Parish, does **AMEND** Chapter 12, Mobile Homes and Mobile Home Parks; Trailers and Trailer Parks; House Courts, Tent Camp Spaces, Etc; Article II, House Courts, Tent Camp Spaces, Etc.; Section 12-56, Violations and Article III, Flood and Wind Protection; Section 12-66, Penalty of the St. Bernard Parish Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as per attached Exhibit "A".

**SECTION 2.** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval of the State of Louisiana. In the event of a presidential veto, this Ordinance shall become effective upon a two-thirds favorable vote of the total membership of the Council and then approved by the State of Louisiana pursuant to Sections 2-11 and 2-13 of the St. Bernard Parish Home Rule Charter.

**SECTION 3.** Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expressing and declaring that it would have adopted the remaining portion of this ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.

**Ordinance SBPC #2695-11-25**

**Chapter 12 – Mobile Homes and Mobile Home Parks; Trailers and Trailer Parks;  
House Courts, Tent Camp Spaces, etc.**

**Article II – House Courts, Tent Camp Spaces, etc.**

**Sec. 12-56 – Violations**

Any violation of any provision of this chapter shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction in a court of competent jurisdiction the offender shall be fined not less than one thousand (\$1000.00) or be imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days, or both, in the discretion of the court for the first offense; and for the second offense shall be fined not less than fifteen hundred (\$1500.00) and or be imprisoned for not more than sixty (60) days.

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**Chapter 12 – Mobile Homes and Mobile Home Parks; Trailers and Trailer Parks;  
House Courts, Tent Camp Spaces, etc.**

**Article III – Flood and Wind Protection**

**Sec. 12-66. - Penalty**

The penalty for noncompliance with the provisions of this article shall be a two hundred fifty (\$250.00) fine for every day a manufactured home site does not comply with this article.
