## **RESOLUTION SBPC #1769-11-17**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LOUISIANA CAPITAL OUTLAY APPLICATIONS FOR FY2018-2019 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,523,762.00.

**WHEREAS**, the State of Louisiana has established a Capital Outlay Program which is presented annually to the Louisiana Legislature by the Governor of Louisiana for funding consideration; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the Capital Outlay Program is to fund state and local public facilities or infrastructure projects not eligible for funding under a dedicated State program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Capital Outlay Program allows applications from State and Local agencies and typically awards an estimated 20-30% of Capital Outlay funding to non-state entities like St. Bernard Parish Government; and

**WHEREAS**, the capital needs and requirements of the Parish Government were reviewed and prioritized in order to prepare applications for Capital Outlay funding consideration.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** the St. Bernard Parish Council, does hereby authorize the submission of the following Capital Outlay Program applications for fiscal year 2018-2019 to Governor John Bel Edwards for funding consideration:

Renovations will include updating the HVAC systems, replacing rusted exterior window frames, replacing water pipes, installing new hot water heaters, replacing the roof and renovating the restroom, showers, and all doors.

Our second priority is to purchase equipment to address the over-grown drainage canals and levees throughout the Parish. Without this equipment, residential dwellings and businesses are more likely to flood during major rain events. St. Bernard is important to the New Orleans region as a whole and to the State of Louisiana as it is home to significant oil and gas facilities, the largest sugar refinery in the western hemisphere, and an employment base that serves New Orleans and the entire metro area.
