BERNARD PARISH GOVERNMENT COMPLEX, 8201 WEST JUDGE PEREZ DRIVE, CHALMETTE, LOUISIANA ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 21, 2018 AT THREE O'CLOCK P.M.

On motion of Mr. Gorbaty, seconded by Mr. Lewis, it was moved to adopt the following ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE SBPC #681-11-06, WHICH PLACED A MORATORIUM ON CONSTRUCTION OF DOCKS, SLIPS AND LIVING QUARTERS ON BAYOU YSCLOSKEY UNTIL THE WATER BOTTOM OWNERSHIP CONFLICT IS RESOLVED.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of St. Bernard Parish for its citizens to use and enjoy Bayou Yscloskey; and,

WHEREAS, the moratorium on the construction of docks, slips and living quarters, no longer serves the public interest,

ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance SBPC #681-11-06 placing a moratorium on construction of docks, slips and living quarters on Bayou Yscloskey until the water bottom ownership conflict is resolved is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon authorizing signature by the Parish President. In the event of a presidential veto, this Ordinance shall become effective upon a two-thirds favorable vote of the total membership of the Council pursuant to Sections 2-11 and 2-13 of the St. Bernard Parish Home Rule Charter.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this Ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expresses and declares that it would have adopted the remaining portion of this Ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.
