AN ORDINANCE TO **AMEND** CHAPTER 22; ZONING, SECTION 22-7; SITE DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS, SUBSECTION 22-7-4 SIGN REGULATIONS IN THE ST. BERNARD PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES.

ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. That St. Bernard Parish does hereby amend Chapter 22; Zoning, Section 22-7; Site Development Standards, Subsection 22-7-4 sign regulations as per attached in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon authorizing signature by the Parish President. In the event of a presidential veto, this Ordinance shall become effective upon a two-thirds favorable vote of the total membership of the Council pursuant to Sections 2-11 and 2-13 of the St. Bernard Parish Home Rule Charter.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this Ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expresses and declares that it would have adopted the remaining portion this Ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.

The above and foregoing having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereupon resulted as follows:

Chapter 22 - ZONING

Sec. 22-7. - Site development standards

22-7-4 Sign regulations

22-7-4.5. Dimensions, conditions, and restrictions for sign types

- (n) Political signs. *Political signs shall not exceed thirty-two (32) square feet in commercial, industrial and agriculture zoned areas and shall not exceed eight (8) square feet in residential zoned areas. Said signs shall be allowed for no more than ninety (90) consecutive calendar days and must be removed within ten (10) days following election for which signs were permitted. If signs are for more than one (1) election, the permit will automatically extend to the tenth day following the subsequent election.*
- (1) Political signs are not permitted in public rights-of-way, and are not allowed to obstruct vehicular lines of vision.
- (2) Said signs are not allowed to be stacked one on top of another, like in billboard fashion.

22-7-4.7. Application requirements and fee schedule

- (b) Fees. When completed application is submitted with required information, a nonrefundable application fee shall be required according to the following schedule:
7. Political signs. Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)
