On motion of Mr. Montelongo, seconded by Mr. McCloskey, it was moved to adopt the following resolution:

## RESOLUTION SBPC #1864-08-18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE NATIONAL FISH AND WILDLIFE FOUNDATION (NFWF) COASTAL RESILIENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000.00 FOR THE EAST BANK SEDIMENT PIPELINE PRELIMINARY DESIGN PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (NFWF) Coastal Resiliency Program restores, increases and strengthens natural infrastructure to protect coastal communities while also enhancing habitats for fish and wildlife; and

WHEREAS, the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (NFWF) Coastal Resiliency fund will invest up to \$30,000,000.00 in conservation projects that restore or expand natural features such as coastal marshes and wetlands, dune and beach systems, oyster and coral reefs, forests, coastal rivers, and barrier islands that minimize the impacts of storms and other naturally occurring events on nearby communities; and

WHEREAS, St. Bernard wishes to apply for is National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (NFWF) Coastal Resiliency Fund in the amount of \$250,000.00; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the St. Bernard Parish Council, does hereby authorize the submission of the grant application in the amount of \$250,000.00 for the East Bank Sediment Pipeline Preliminary Design (\$250,000.00 from NFWF, \$274,405.00 from St. Bernard Parish Government Coastal budget and \$524,405.00 from the CPRA Grant); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the St. Bernard Parish Council does hereby authorize the President of St. Bernard Parish Government to sign and submit all required grant applications, Cooperative Endeavor Agreements and any amendments thereof, and all of the necessary reports, assurances, contracts and any other documents required in connection with the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (NFWF) Coastal Resiliency Fund.


The Council Chair, Ms. Callais, cast her vote as YEA.
