President's Report

Council Meeting of Tuesday, February 19, 2019

Good afternoon Council Members, Ladies and Gentlemen:

PJA CONVENTION – We attended the Police Jury Association Convention held last week in Lake Charles. The 3 day conference included sessions on various topics including Coastal Parishes Caucus, Wildlife and Fisheries, Parks, Recreation and Tourism, Community Development, Environment and Energy, Emergency Preparedness and Drainage, Fire Prevention and Public Works and Waterworks

COASTAL – Our Coastal Department is in the process of updating their RESTORE Act Multiyear Implementation Plan (MIP), which includes a number of coastal and economic development activities that are intended to mitigate the impacts of the BP Oil Spill. The original MIP was approved in 2017 and is now being amended for the second time. The most recent proposed amendments to the MIP are available for public comment through March 25, 2019. PARIS ROAD CORRIDOR – We are partnering with Linfield, Hunter, and Junius, Inc. to host a community meeting to discuss ideas for enhancing the Paris Road Corridor from the St. Bernard/Orleans parish line to the Nunez Community College Administration Building. The meeting will take place on **Wednesday, February 27, 2019** from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. in Nunez Community College's Fine Arts Building.
