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Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) Program

The Community Services Block Grant (CSBG), administered by the Louisiana Workforce Commission, provides core funding to local agencies to reduce poverty, revitalize low-income communities and to empower low-income families to become self-sufficient.

Under the Disaster Policy, the program will provide financial assistance in the form of non-congregate shelter (hotel stay) and/or rental assistance, up to 6 months of past rental payments for those affected by the recent tornado. Eligible applicants, may also qualify for assistance with utility deposits, rental deposits and household necessities.

Applicants will be required to complete an application and submit all required documentation to apply for assistance. To qualify, an applicant must be identified as a recent tornado victim by authorities (Red Cross, FEMA, etc.) and meet the federal poverty guidelines. (see below)

Referrals are sent to the Housing and Redevelopment Department to complete applications for assistance.

Qualifications for this CSBG assistance are based on need and income.
