A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE LOUISIANA COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE'S 2016 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,300.00 FOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE TECHNOLOGY IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE 34TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of Criminal Justice issued a call for projects with funding provided by U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the primary purpose of this program is to provide criminal justice funding to state and local government to support components of the criminal justice system for crime prevention; drug and gang task forces; violence programs; courts; corrections; treatment; and justice information sharing technology initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the Parish received grant funding under this program in 2014 to provide Magistrate Court cameras for the 34th Judicial District; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for additional computer equipment to run software for the Magistrate Court.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the St. Bernard Parish Council, does hereby authorize the submission of a Notice of Intent for a grant application to the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of Criminal Justice's 2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant program in the amount of \$3,300.00 (no local matching funds required) for Criminal Justice Technology Improvements for the 34th Judicial District Court; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the St. Bernard Parish Council, does hereby authorize the President of St. Bernard Parish Government to sign and submit all required grant applications, Cooperative Endeavor Agreements and any amendments thereof, and all of the necessary reports, assurances, contracts and any other documents required in connection with the 2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant program application process.






